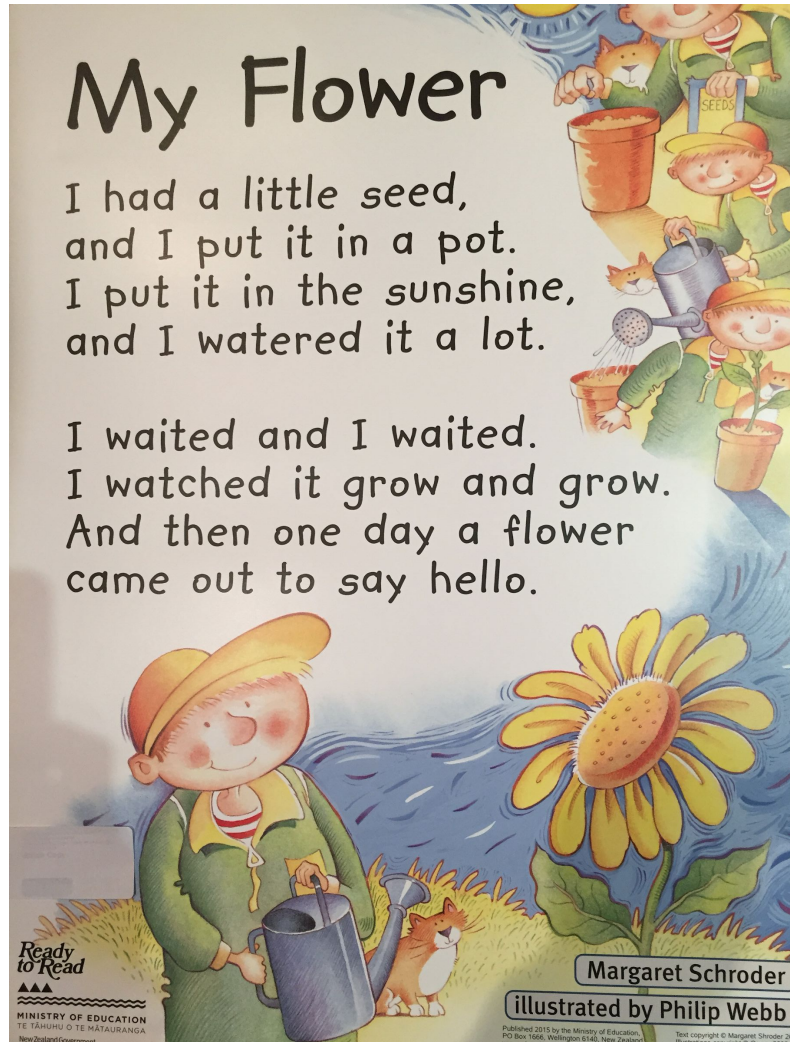

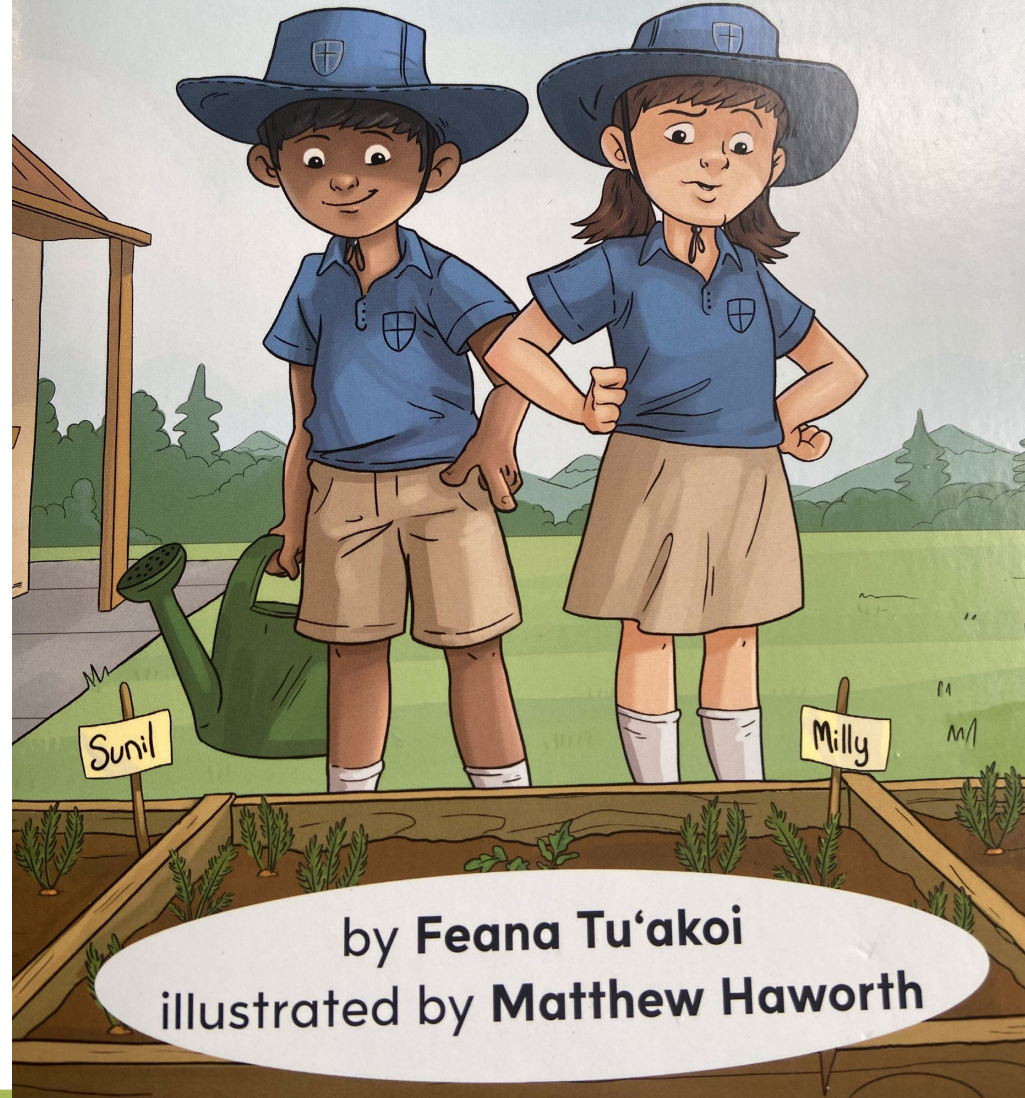

“Now we have to wait,” I said.

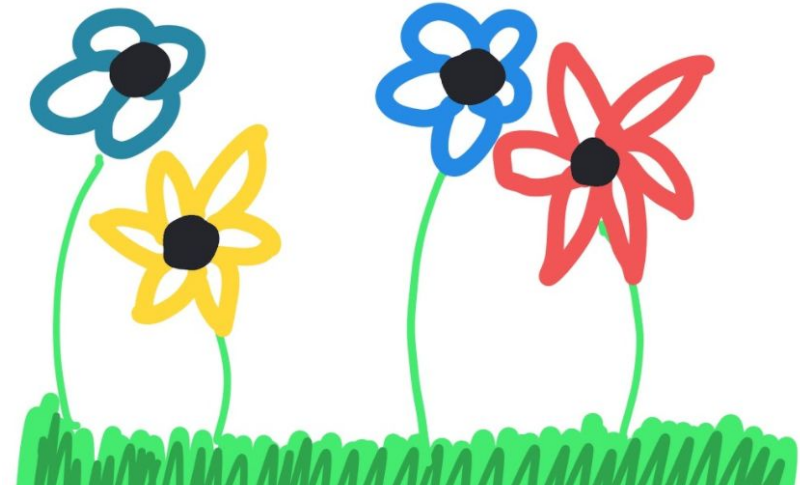


The plants began to grow.
